All Explorers need to arrive to Eppley Airfield by 12:30 pm. Our flight departs at 3:14 pm. We are on Alaska Airlines #312.

Transportation calendar appointments were sent to each location's staff members with the details of your trip. The community will be providing you with transportation and a driver.

As you arrive to the airport, the Immanuel and Allied team will make sure all your luggage is tagged with the color-coded luggage tags that were provided by Cameo ahead of time. Please make sure you inform Cameo if you cannot find them as we get closer to the trip dates. These will be distributed in early June.

Beth, Lisa, Jameon, Sara, and Cameo (Immanuel staff), and our Allied Tour Director, DeEtta are excited to host you. We encourage you to plan ahead for any snacks, refreshments, or meal purchases you plan to make at the airport or eating before arrival (according to your transportation schedule).

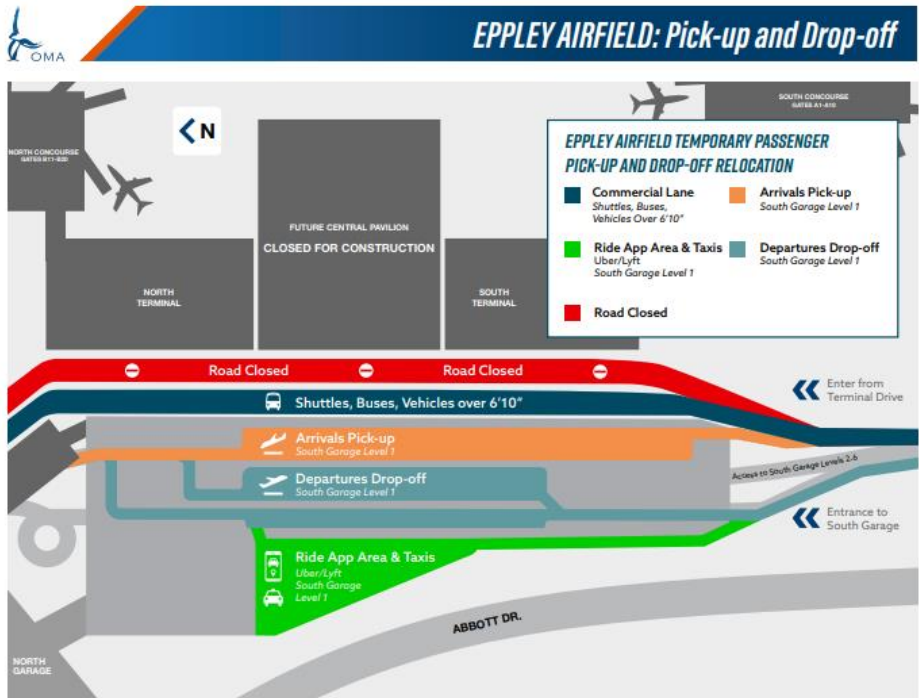
DAY 1 OUTLINE OF SCHEDULE – Saturday, June 20, 2026

12:30 pm – All Explorers arrive at Eppley Airfield – Omaha - Concourse A is where passengers are dropped off. It is the South Terminal on Level 1.

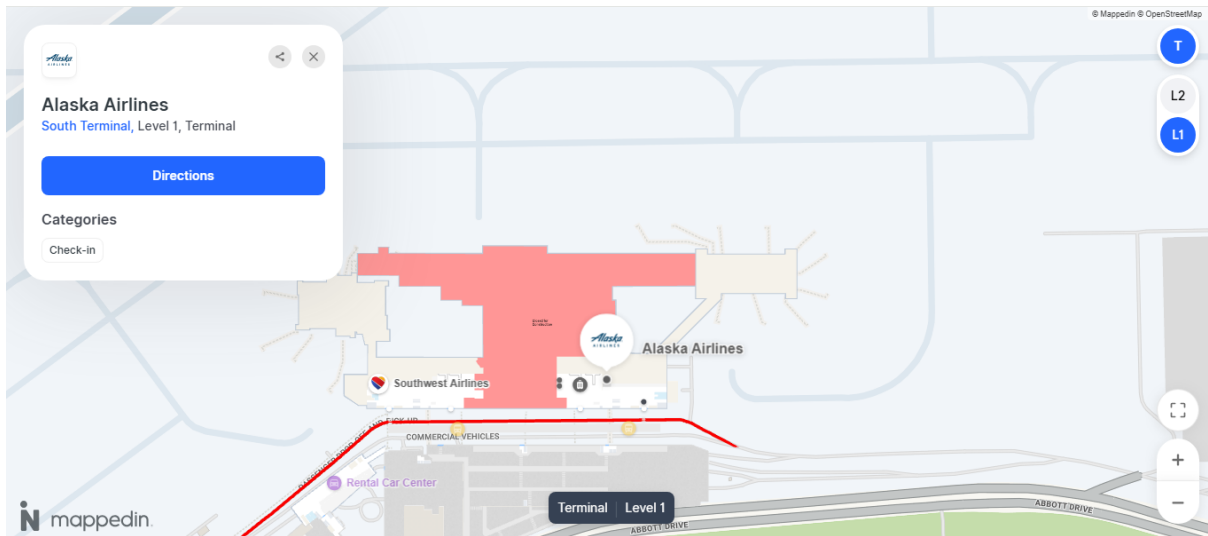
**Explorers staff will be at the entryway area where passengers are dropped off to help support Explorers with arrival, navigating to the check-in area, and luggage.*

REMINDERS:

Don't forget your driver's license AND passports (or government issued photo ID.) Driver's licenses must have a "star" on them in the upper right-hand corner (Real-ID) to be considered valid. Please have these items on you.

Time Zones:

Seattle is in the Pacific Time Zone – it is two hours behind the Central Time Zone.

Seat Assignments: Your boarding passes will be available at check-in with Alaska Airlines

Please note: Airlines typically serve drinks on board with a small snack such as pretzels. Please be sure to have snacks with you during your flights in the event you get hungry or there are delays.

Luggage Restrictions:

As baggage restrictions & requirements are continually changing, we ask that you read the information on the next page carefully. If you have any questions on what you can or cannot take, please call Allied Tours at 800-672-1009.

Carry-on luggage cannot exceed 45 linear inches or a recommended 22" long X 14" wide by 9" high. You are limited to one carry on plus one additional item such as a purse, camera bag, or similar, your personal item must be stored under the seat in front of you.

- **Reminder: Liquids, gels, pastes and/or aerosols are permitted through security checkpoints. But items must fit in one clear, re-sealable quart or liter sized bag, in containers of 3 ounces or less.** Plastic bags must be completely sealed and will be sent through x-ray separately. Examples include shampoo, creams, toothpaste, hair gel, hair spray, liquid cosmetics and other items of similar consistency.
- The following items are allowed but may be examined by TSA officials at security checkpoints if they are not in a secured plastic bag or are more than 3 ounces: Medications (liquid, gel or aerosol); liquids, juices or gels for diabetics who indicate a need for their medical condition; baby formula & food if traveling with a small child.

- Bottled water, pop, tea, etc., cannot be taken through the security check point. If you wish to purchase a drink after you go through security in the boarding area, you may do so. Or bring an empty water bottle with you to fill after going through security.
- Sharp items such as scissors, knives, pocketknives, etc., are not allowed to be carried on the plane. Please make sure these are in your checked luggage. Firearms are not allowed on planes or ships.
- We encourage you to have your CPAP, Bi-Pap and important medications/treatments as a carry-on item and NOT in checked luggage. These items are generally not considered as your personal item and may be brought in addition to personal item.

Checked luggage Bags cannot weigh over 50 pounds and should not be larger than 62 linear inches (combined length, width & height). The airlines reserve the right to charge extra for luggage that is overweight or oversized. A permanent luggage tag, including your name & contact information, is required on the outside of your bag, and it is recommended that you put it on the inside as well.

Luggage fees: All luggage fees will be paid at checking payable to Alaska Airlines. Alaska Airlines is currently charging \$35.00 for the first checked bag. This is subject to change at the airline's discretion. We suggest you limit yourself to one checked bag. Airlines will charge for baggage more than 50 pounds with a surcharge of \$100-\$150 per bag or more.

4:58 pm – Arrive in Seattle, go with Explorers staff and Allied Tour and Travel staff to baggage claim area before heading to transportation pick-up area as a group.
